

# It's holy smoke & old Nick's bangers

A FIREWORK enthusiast's plans went up in smoke for all the right reasons when he helped organise the largest display launched off a single building in Europe.

Nick Cantwell, of Overseal, was one of 17 people working for the Fantastic Fireworks group, charged with providing the celebrations for Liverpool's Anglican Cathedral centenary.

The British Pyromania Authority-accredited worker



helped set up and design the £28,000 spectacular.

It amounted to 35,000 fireworks, weighing a six tonnes, all linked by 4km worth of cable.

The incredible display was soundtracked live by local music station, Radio City and lasted for 20 minutes.

Mr Cantwell said:

“Everything went with a bang.”
